**Mossley AFC was begun over a hundred years ago and have played at the picturesque Seel Park on Market Street since 1912.**

After more than fifty years in the Cheshire League, Mossley joined to the Northern Premier League in 1972 and during the late 70's grew into a formidable force in non-league football. They won successive League titles in the late seventies and finished second place in each of the next three seasons. With influential manager Bob Murphy (now Club President) at the helm the club also saw it's greatest moment when, in May 1980 the Lilywhites (as the are nick-named) reach Wembley for the Final of the F.A.Challenge Trophy. Mossley unluckily lost 2-1 in the final to Dagenham and Mossley took over 10,000 fans to the famous stadium. A memorable day for the Club and town was captured for posterity by Granada TV in their prime time documentary "Mossley Goes To Wembley."

In recent times the Club has gone through many changes with a mixture of success and more challenging times. But, with the hard work and support of the people of Mossley and the surrounding area have always maintained a high standard of semi professional football.

The club are getting ready for the new season. With manager Chris Willcock (a former Mossley player) in charge for his second season and is preparing a high quality team with a blend of youth and experience for the coming term. It promises to be an exciting season with the Lilywhites hopefully pushing for promotion or a play off place in the coming months.

The pre-season begins on Wednesday 15th July (7.30 pm) with a home game against Coca Cola League 2 team Bury. Admission to the game is £5 for adults and £2 for senior citizens, students and unwaged. Children 16 or under are admitted for £1 accompanied by an adult or otherwise. The Social Club will be open and there will be food and refreshments available.

Seel Park boasts it's own active social club with events held throughout the year.

There are lots of opportunities to get involved with your local club as a helper or a fan and you will be made to feel welcome at our friendly football family club!

# MOSSLEY JUNIORS

Mossley Juniors are a dedicated team of volunteers who coach and manage various aged football teams from under 7's to under 16's, including an under 13's girls team. The girls team in particular are always looking for more players, currently we have an under 13's team and we also have a number of girls who come, simply to train with us. We hope to increase our numbers so we are able to enter 2 teams into our girls league. Any girls who are interested in playing and are aged between 8 and 14 years, please contact Joanne Blackshaw through Mossley Juniors website.

Our teams play in a number of different leagues including Tameside, East Manchester and Oldham Girls League ( to be known as North Manchester Girls league from September 2009). We train at various venues around Mossley, Top Mossley Park and Egmont Street moving to indoor venues during the winter months. The Managers and coaches have all gained their football coaching certificates and some are qualified referees.

Since 2008 we have had an affiliation with Mossley AFC, enabling us to work together to raise our profile and to try and raise more funds but more importantly, to hopefully give possible opportunities for our young players to play at a local club level, when they have progressed through the Juniors age groups.

As a Junior club, we use Seel Park as a venue for our fundraising events, more recently on Monday 25th May 2009, we held a Parents Tournament where Joanne Blackshaw's Under 12's girls' parents won the final against Alan Broadbent's Under 13's boy's parents. It was a glorious day and a great event for our kids, who took advantage of the opportunity to 'mirror their parents enthusiasm' by shouting encouraging phrases such as "put more effort into it!", "I could have made that shot!", and the inevitable "How wide do you want the nets!!" (For future reference, be careful parents when shouting 'advice' to your children from the touchline, you never know when they'll get you back!)

Our Junior club is always striving to do better and help our young people achieve more. We are trying, as we enter into this new phase at Mossley AFC, to encourage our Juniors and other children in the Mossley schools, to come along and support their local team and perhaps we can, in the future, form a Junior Supporters branch, who knows?
